These RULES apply to the Open ABGA and Wether show.

1. The Open show will be sanctioned by the ABGA and their rules shall govern in case of a discrepancy, or for rules not adequately covered, the show secretary's decision and or judge's decision will be final.
2. The breeding classes will use the birth dates, as listed on the registration papers, to determine the class divisions. The show date will be the base date for computing all ages.
3. Original registration certificates are required (though a copy of a registration application, stamped with the date received by one of the listed associations, can be accepted for kids less than 3 months of age.) Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before the date determined by the show.
4. All animals must be in place and registration papers checked in with the show secretary by 8:00AM on the date of the show.
5. No refunds on pre-paid entries. There is a \$40.00 service charge on all NSF checks.
6. All goats must be healthy with no visible signs of ascesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, sore mouth, ringworm, etc.). Unhealthy or questionable animals checked by the veterinarian will be at the owner's expense. The French City Classic reserves the right to excuse any animal of questionable health without a refund.
7. ALL out of state goats must have their health papers (including recipient does) and proper tests as needed by the State of Ohio. Health certificates must be dated within 30 days of the show. ALL out of state exhibitors must be at the fairgrounds at 8:00AM on date of the show and need to have their health papers checked by the veterinarian by 9:00AM or they will not be able to show, and

will also forfeit any entry fees. Ohio goats will not require health papers.

8. ALL goats must comply with the Ohio scrapie rules. All questions can be answered by the Ohio State Veterinarian at (614)469-5602.

9. The French City Classic Show and/or the fairgrounds will not be held responsible for loss, damages or accidents. Any person or family not acting in an honorable manner will be required to leave immediately and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the show. Absolutely NO alcohol or drugs are allowed on the premises.

10. Wethers will be weighed on our scale at the time of check in.
