## DISCLAIMER

1. The Open breeding show will be sanctioned by the American Boer Goat Association (ABGA) and their rules shall govern. In case of discrepancy or for rules not adequately covered, the show committee's decision and/or judges decision is final.
2. The breeding classes will use the birth dates, as listed on the registration certificate, to determine the class divisions. The show date will be the base date for computing all ages.
3. Original registration certificates are required, though a copy of a Registration Application, stamped with the date received by one of the listed associations, can be accepted for kids less than 3 months of age. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before date determined by said show.
4. All animals must be in place, and registration papers checked in with the show secretary, by 8 a.m. the day of the show. **Pen availability will be on a first come basis.**
5. If entries were received within the appropriate time (on or before the postmarked deadline) then two additional animals can be added at the regular entry fee. If more than two animals need to be added after the postmark deadline then double fees will be charged. Substitutions are allowed. **No refunds.** There will be a \$35.00 service charge for NSF checks.
6. All animals must be healthy. No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, sore mouth, ringworm etc.) will be allowed. Any unhealthy or questionable animals checked by the veterinarian will be at the owner's expense. The Guernsey Co. Boer Goat Committee reserves the right to excuse any animal of questionable health.
7. All out of state animals must have health papers (including recipient does) and proper tests needed by the state of Ohio. All out of state exhibitors must be at the fairgrounds at 8:00a.m. (on the day of the show) to have health papers checked by the veterinarian or they will not be able to show, and will forfeit all entry fees. No health papers are required for Ohio goats.
8. All goats must comply with Ohio scrapie rules. Questions: contact the Ohio State Veterinarian at 614-469-5602.
9. The Guernsey County Boer Goat Committee, Guernsey County fairgrounds and/ or American Boer Goat Association (ABGA) will not be held responsible for loss, damages or accidents.
10. Any person or family not acting in an honorable manner will be required to leave immediately, and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the show.
11. The ABGA shows will have class placing of first through sixth with ribbons awarded through fifth place. The show premiums will be based on number of entrants.
12. The scales for the wethers will be open from 7:00am-on Saturday April 26<sup>th</sup>. The scales will close promptly when all goats in line have been weighed. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
13. Entrants responsible for bringing own bedding. A booth will be set up to provide bedding.

- 3) ANIMALS FROM OUT OF STATE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY HEALTH PAPERS.
- 4) OWNERS RESPONSIBILITY TO BE IN LINE FOR SALE ORDER. FAILURE TO DO SO FORFEITS SALE POSITION AND REQUIRES SELLING AT END OF SALE.
- 5) ALL GOATS ARE AT THE OWNER'S RISK UNTIL SOLD, AT WHICH TIME THE GOATS BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE BUYER. ANY VETERINARY FEES BEFORE THE SALE WILL BE CHARGED TO THE EXIBITOR. OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR RECEIVING A RELEASE ON THEIR ANIMAL FROM THE PURCHASER FOLLOWING THE SALE OF THE ANIMAL.
- 6) PAYMENT TO THE CONSIGNORS MAY BE WITHHELD BY THE GUERNSEY COUNTY BOER GOAT COMMITTEE UNTIL ALL CHECKS HAVE CLEARED, AFTER WHICH PAYMENT WILL BE MADE
- 7) CONSIGNMENT DEADLINE DATE MUST BE POST MARKED BY MARCH 24, 2008.

- 9) WETHERS DATE OF BIRTH MUST BE BORN ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 1, 2007. (Milk teeth rule will apply)
- 10) THE GUERNSEY COUNTY BOER GOAT COMMITTEE, THE GUERNSEY COUNTY FAIR BOARD OFFICIALS OR AGENTS, INCLUDING THE TOWN OF OLD WASHINGTON NOR THE ABGA WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOSS OR DAMAGE OF ANY PERSON (S) ANIMAL(S) PROPERTY DAMAGE OR MISSING PROPERTY AT THE SHOW OR SALE
- 11) ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY. NO VISIBLE SIGNS OF ABSCESES OR OTHER CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (PINKEYE, SORE MOUTH, RING WORM, ETC.) WILL BE ALLOWED. ANY UNHEALTHY OR QUESTIONABLE ANIMAL CHECKED BY THE VETERINARIAN WILL BE AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE. THE GUERNSEY COUNTY BOER GOAT COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXCUSE ANY ANIMAL FROM THE SALE THAT IS IN QUESTIONABLE HEALTH.
- 12) REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY THE ANIMAL FOR TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP PURPOSES. EXCEPTIONS WOULD BE FOR KIDS SOLD ON MOTHERS SIDE ( FAMILY SELLS AS ONE LOT)
- 13) MUST MEET BREED STANDARDS.
- 14) ALL ENTRY FEES APPLY, PLEASE MAKE SURE TO INDICATE IF YOU PLAN TO SHOW THE YOUR SALE ENTRY WITH AN \*. ENTRY FEES APPLY TO ALL, IF ANIMAL IS IN THE SHOW YOU DO NOT NEED TO PAY ENTRY FEE TWICE ONLY IF ANIMAL IS NOT SHOWING DO YOU NEED TO PAY SALE ENTRY FEE.
