Open and Junior Boer Goat Show, and Jackpot Wether Show

Shelby County Fairgrounds - 655 S Highland Ave., Sidney, OH 45365

Directions to the fairgrounds: exit 90 on I-75 head East on Fair Rd. Turn left on 4th Ave., then turn right on Campbell Rd. Turn right at next light past the Elementary school.

Show starts at 9:00am OMGA Summer Wether Series show #4, followed by the JABGA show, followed by the ABGA sanctioned show. Judge: Johanna Dodds, CA.

Entries must be postmarked on or before August 30, 2008. Double fees will apply after this date. No e-mail or phone entries accepted.

The following rules apply to the ABGA, JABGA and Summer Wether Series Shows:

1. The Open and Junior breeding show will be sanctioned by the American Boer Goat Association (ABGA) and their rules shall govern. In case of discrepancy, or for rules not adequately covered, the OMGA Board of Directors and/or judges decision is final.
2. A Junior ABGA (JABGA) member must be under the age of 19 on January 1st of the current year.
3. The breeding classes will use the birth dates, as listed on the registration certificate, to determine the class divisions. The show date will be the base date for computing all ages.
4. **Original registration certificates are required**, though a copy of a Registration Application, stamped with the date received by one of the listed associations, can be accepted for kids less than 3 months of age. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before date determined by said show.
5. Goats entered in the JABGA show must be registered in the name of the JABGA exhibitor. JABGA exhibitors are responsible for showing their own animals. If the JABGA exhibitor has more than one entry in a class, the other goat(s) must be shown by another JABGA member.
6. All animals must be in place, and registration papers checked in with the show secretary, by 8 a.m. the day of the show. Pen availability will be on a first come basis.
7. If entries were received within the appropriate time (on or before the postmarked deadline) then two additional entries can be added at the regular entry fee. If more than two entries need to be added after the postmark deadline then double fees will be charged. Substitutions are allowed. No refunds. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for NSF checks.
8. All animals must be healthy. No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm etc.) will be allowed. Any unhealthy or questionable animals checked by the veterinarian will be at the owner's expense. The OMGA reserves the right to excuse any animal of questionable health.
9. All out of state animals must have health papers (including recipient does) and proper tests needed by the state of Ohio. All out of state exhibitors must be at the fairgrounds at 8:00a.m. (on the day of the show) to have health papers checked by the veterinarian or they will not be able to show, and will forfeit all entry fees. No health papers are required for Ohio goats.
10. All goats must comply with Ohio scrapie rules. Questions: contact the Ohio State Veterinarian at 614-469-5602.
11. The Ohio Meat Goat Association and/or this fairground will not be held responsible for loss, damages or accidents.
12. Any person or family not acting in an honorable manner will be required to leave immediately, and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the show.
13. The ABGA and JABGA shows will have class placings of first through fifth with ribbons awarded. The ABGA show will have class premiums of \$7, \$5, and \$3. The junior show will have class premiums of \$10, \$8, \$6, \$4 and \$2.
14. There will be no bucks shown in the JABGA show.
15. The scales for the wethers will be open from 7:00am-8:30am on the morning of the show. The scales will close promptly at 8:30am (or when all goats in line have been weighed). If you are not in line to be weighed by 8:30am you will not be weighed; **no exceptions**. The scales will not be held open (nor be reopened) if you are not in line to be weighed. Depending on the number of wether entries, the scales may be open the night before the show from 7:00pm-8:00pm.

New for 2008 – Limit of 3 wethers maximum to be shown per exhibitor.



The Wether Series show is open to any junior exhibitor from five years to eighteen years of age (as of January 1 of the current year). Limit of three wethers maximum. All wethers must be castrated males and have their milk teeth in place. Wethers will be weighed Friday evening and/or Saturday morning. Classes will be divided by weight, with a maximum of twenty head per class. Wether series committee and/or OMGA Board of Directors has final say on classes. All out of state wethers must meet Ohio health regulations and scrapie rules. All out of state exhibitors must be at the fairgrounds at 8:00am (on the day of the show) to have health papers checked by the veterinarian or they will not be able to show, and will forfeit all entry fees.

The scales for the wethers will be open from 7:00am-8:30am on the morning of the show. The scales will close promptly at 8:30am (or when all goats in line have been weighed). If you are not in line to be weighed by 8:30am you will not be weighed; **no exceptions**. The scales will not be held open (nor be reopened) if you are not in line to be weighed. Depending on the number of wether entries, the scales may be open the night before the show from 7:00pm-8:00pm.

A junior exhibitor must show their own goat(s) unless exhibiting more than one goat in a single class. If they have more than one goat in a single class, then another junior exhibitor may show that goat. This also includes championship classes.

***Special note for OMGA junior members-** The OMGA offers OMGA Junior members a chance to compete for the OMGA Summer Wether Series Premier Exhibitor award. Points are given to each OMGA junior member based on class placings. (Champions and Reserves do not receive points.) Bonus points are also given for attending multiple shows. An OMGA junior member can show up to three wethers, but only the member's highest placing wether for that show will receive points. Belt Buckles and prizes through fifth are awarded to the exhibitors that score the highest in the series.

The award is open to any junior, but to be eligible to participate in the 2008 Wether Series point system a junior exhibitor must become a junior member of the Ohio Meat Goat Association before 9:00am, May 3, 2008; which is the start of the OMGA Wether Series shows.
